

Permit Consistency Reviews – General Information

Acts 67, 68 and 127 of 2000 amended the *PA Municipalities Planning Code* (MPC) to direct state agencies to consider and rely on the comprehensive plans of counties and municipalities when reviewing permit applications for facilities and infrastructure¹. The county planning agency, which is Allegheny County Economic Development, is responsible for reviewing applications to determine if the proposed project is consistent with the *Allegheny Places*, the Allegheny County comprehensive plan.

If a determination of consistency with the *Allegheny Places* is required for your permit, the submittal must include information about the project for which the permit is required. In addition to the GIF or CLUL, for example, the submittal should also include a project narrative, site location map and plans or drawings sufficient to show clearly what is proposed. **Incomplete applications will be discarded**. Checklists are also available on the <u>Allegheny Places website</u> [<u>http://www.alleghenyplaces.com/</u>], which applicants can use to evaluate their projects for consistency with *Allegheny Places*. Click the Implementation tab, then click Consistency in the Resources menu.

DO NOT SEND the following applications to Allegheny County Economic Development:

- Act 14 Notifications. Act 14 notifications must sent by <u>certified mail</u> to the attention of either the Allegheny County Council or County Manager.²
- Sewage Facilities Planning Module Permits. Components 4C <u>AND</u> 4B must both be submitted to the Allegheny County Health Department (ACHD).³
