

Grant Consistency Reviews – General Information

Acts 67, 68 and 127 of 2000 amended the *PA Municipalities Planning Code* (MPC) to direct state agencies to consider and rely on the comprehensive plans of counties and municipalities when reviewing applications for the funding of facilities and infrastructure¹. The county planning agency, which is Allegheny County Economic Development, is responsible for reviewing applications to determine if the proposed project is consistent with the *Allegheny Places*, the Allegheny County comprehensive plan.²

All grant applications submitted for review must include the following minimum information:

- 1. Cover letter or completed Request for Grant Consistency Review form
- 2. Project narrative
- 3. Site location map
- 4. Summary of project costs
- 5. Design drawings, illustrations, photographs and any other information that helps to show clearly what is proposed.

Checklists are also available on the *Allegheny Places* website³, which applicants can use to evaluate their projects for consistency with *Allegheny Places*. Feel free to include a copy of the checklist with your submittal.
